IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Electrical Safety

Risk of electrical shock and fire: Follow all warnings to avoid serious injury or death.

Disconnect before service: Always unplug from the AC outlet before installing, modifying, servicing, or cleaning the device.

Do not handle with wet hands: Handling plugs, sockets, or cables with wet hands can lead to electrical shock.

Avoid overloaded outlets: Use only power sources within the rated range (no DC sources, inverters, or inappropriate supplies).

Mechanical & Trip Hazards

Stable placement only: Place on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping, falling, and potential injury.

Secure cables: Arrange power and data cords so they do not create trip hazards; do not let cords be walked on or pinched.

Use & Maintenance

Do not service yourself: Internal access or attempting repairs can expose dangerous components.

Liquid ingress: If liquids or metal objects enter the device, disconnect immediately and seek authorized support.

Unusual operation: If the unit overheats, emits smoke, or makes unusual smells, disconnect immediately and contact support.

Additional Warnings/Cautions for Wall Mounting Electronics

When installing *any* electronic device on a wall using personal tools or equipment, consider these additional cautions:

Electrical & Structural Installation

Check power location: Ensure there's an appropriate, grounded AC outlet available near the mounting location.

Use proper anchors: Select wall anchors and screws rated for the combined weight of the device *and* any mounting bracket; drywall alone will not suffice without anchors or studs.

Verify stud placement: Mounting heavy devices directly into studs or solid backing is safer than relying on drywall anchors.

Avoid hidden utilities: Use a stud finder that also detects live wires and plumbing to prevent drilling into electrical lines or pipes.

Tool Safety

Use correct tools: Power drills, screwdrivers, and levels should be in good condition; wear eye protection and follow tool manufacturer safety rules.

Secure ladder use: If using a ladder, ensure it's stable and on level ground; do not overreach while working.

Device & Cable Management

Strain relief: Avoid stress on power/data cables by using clips or channels; do not let hanging cables pull on the device.

Routing hazards: Route cords to avoid trip hazards or sharp edges that could damage insulation.

Clearances & Heat Dissipation

Maintain clearance: Respect manufacturer-recommended clearances around vents for heat dissipation to minimize fire risk.

Environmental factors: Do not mount near direct sunlight, heat sources, moisture, or areas prone to dust build-up.

Post-Installation Checks

Test stability: Gently push/pull the mounted device to confirm secure attachment.

Power test: After wiring, power up and confirm normal operation without unusual noise, heat, or smells.

INSTALLATION OVERVIEW

Mounting Preparation (If mounting)

- Choose a flat stable surface capable of supporting the ticker's weight of 25 lbs
- Keep at least 2 in (5 cm) clearance from objects
- Avoid mounting near heat sources, vents, or in direct sunlight
- Ensure access to a grounded power outlet and network connection

Mounting Steps (If mounting)

- Mark mounting points clearly on surface
- Secure mounting brackets with appropriate hardware for surface
- Mount the ticker carefully until unit is supported by brackets in place

Stand Setup (If using stand)

- Place stand on flat surface capable of supporting the ticker's weight of 25 lbs
- Place ticker carefully in stand until unit is supported in place

POWER CONNECTION OVERVIEW

Power Connection

- Carefully plug in the ticker's power cable to a grounded power outlet rated for 120 V AC
- Do not route the power cable so it obstructs movement
- Once power cable is fully connected, turn the switch on
